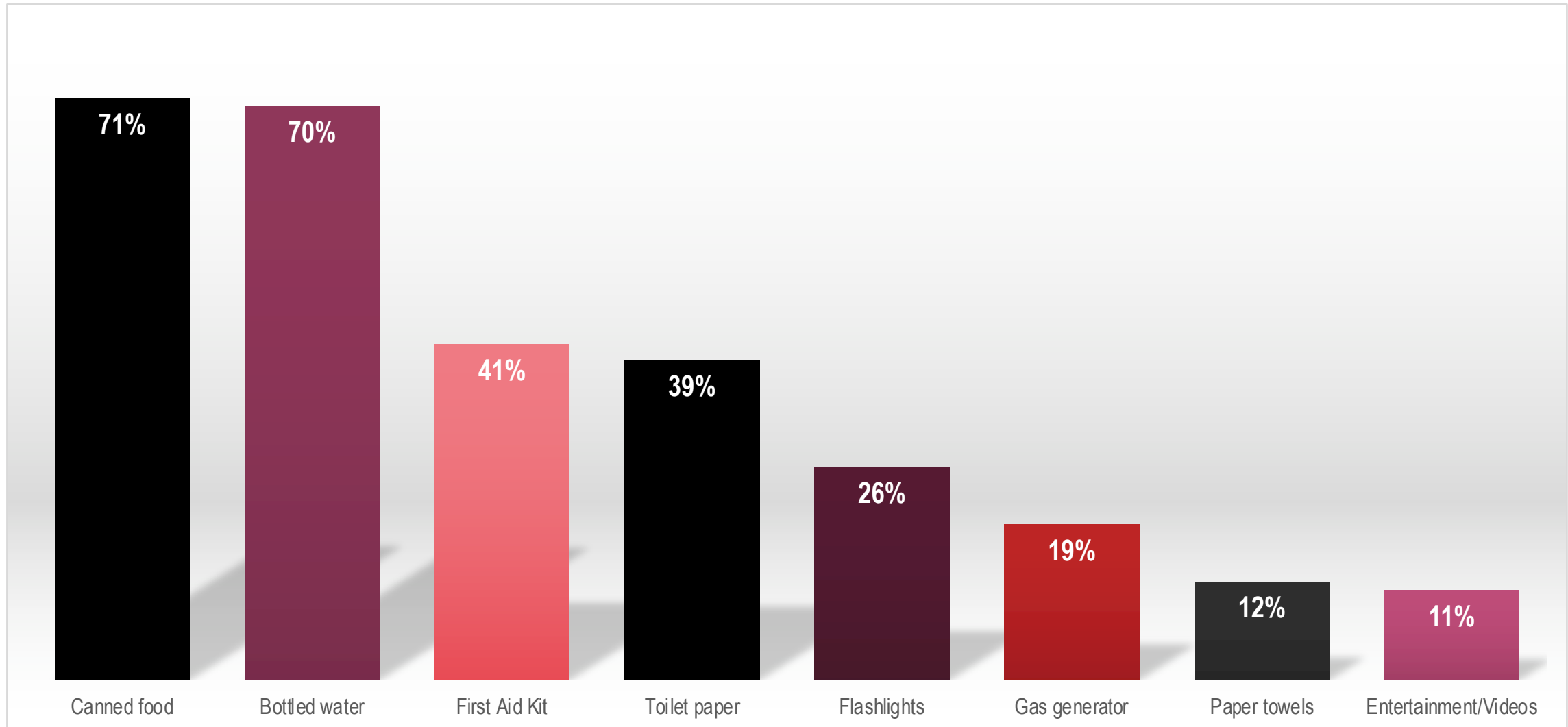

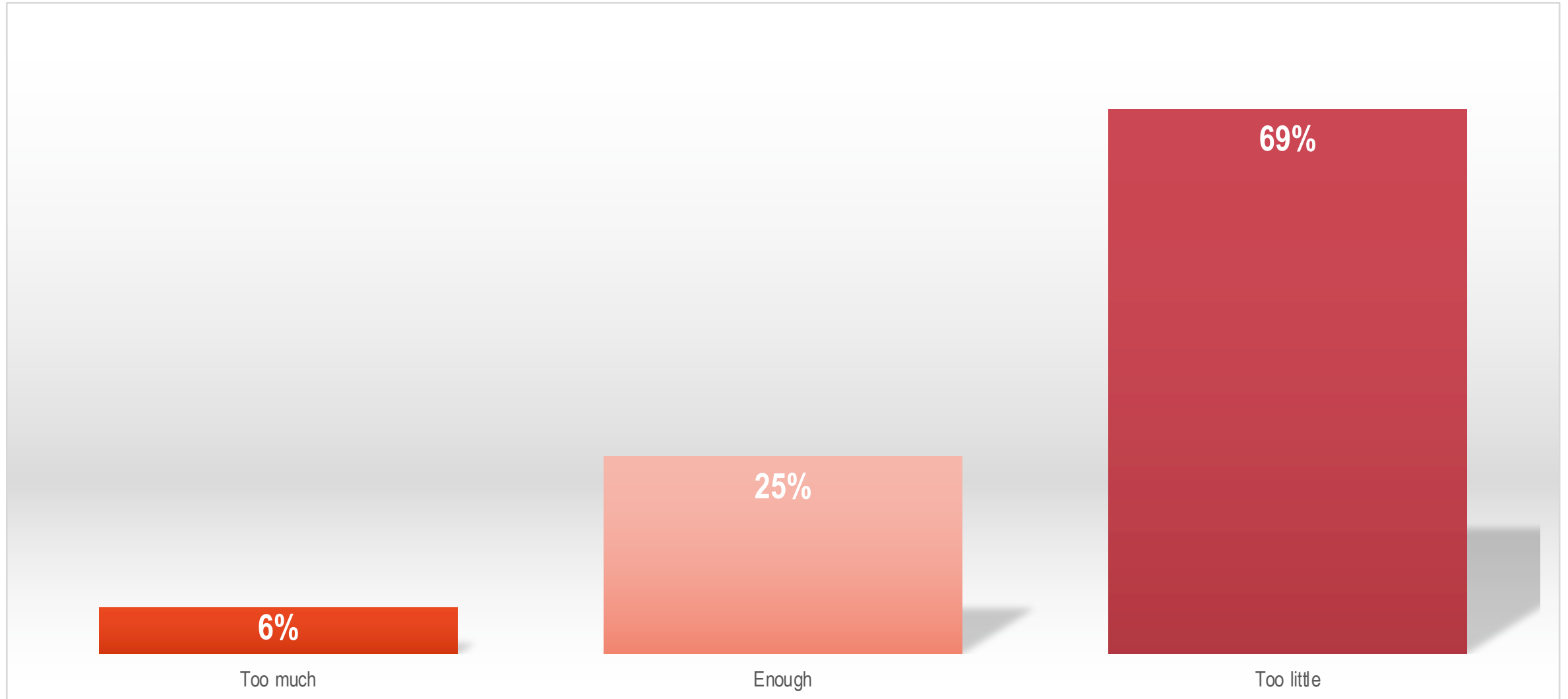

When thinking about your family being prepared for emergencies like the coronavirus or natural disasters, what are the **THREE** most important for you to have on hand at home?

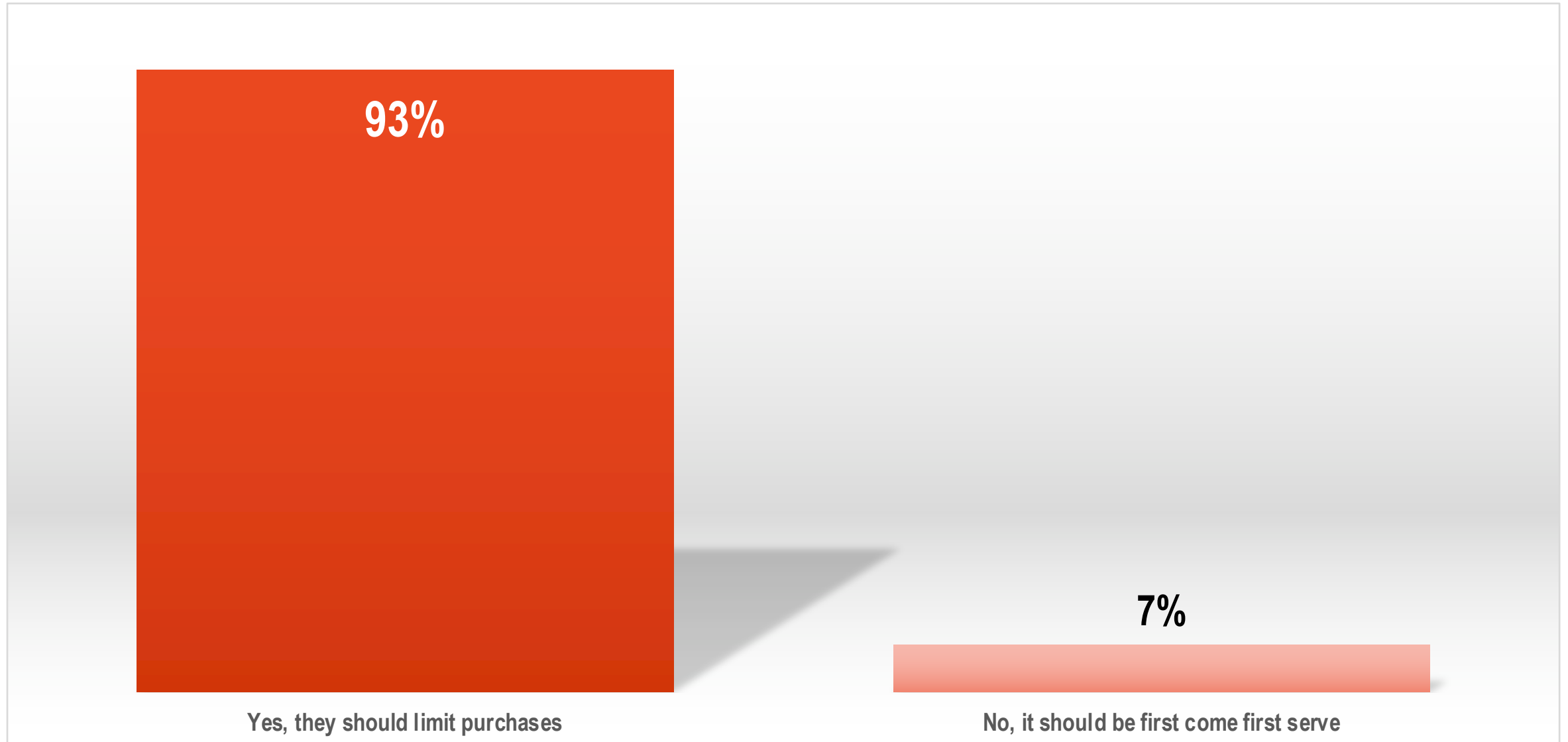

Currently the federal government stockpiles about 1 individually-sized bottle of clean water for every 18 people. Do you think that is too much, enough, or too little?

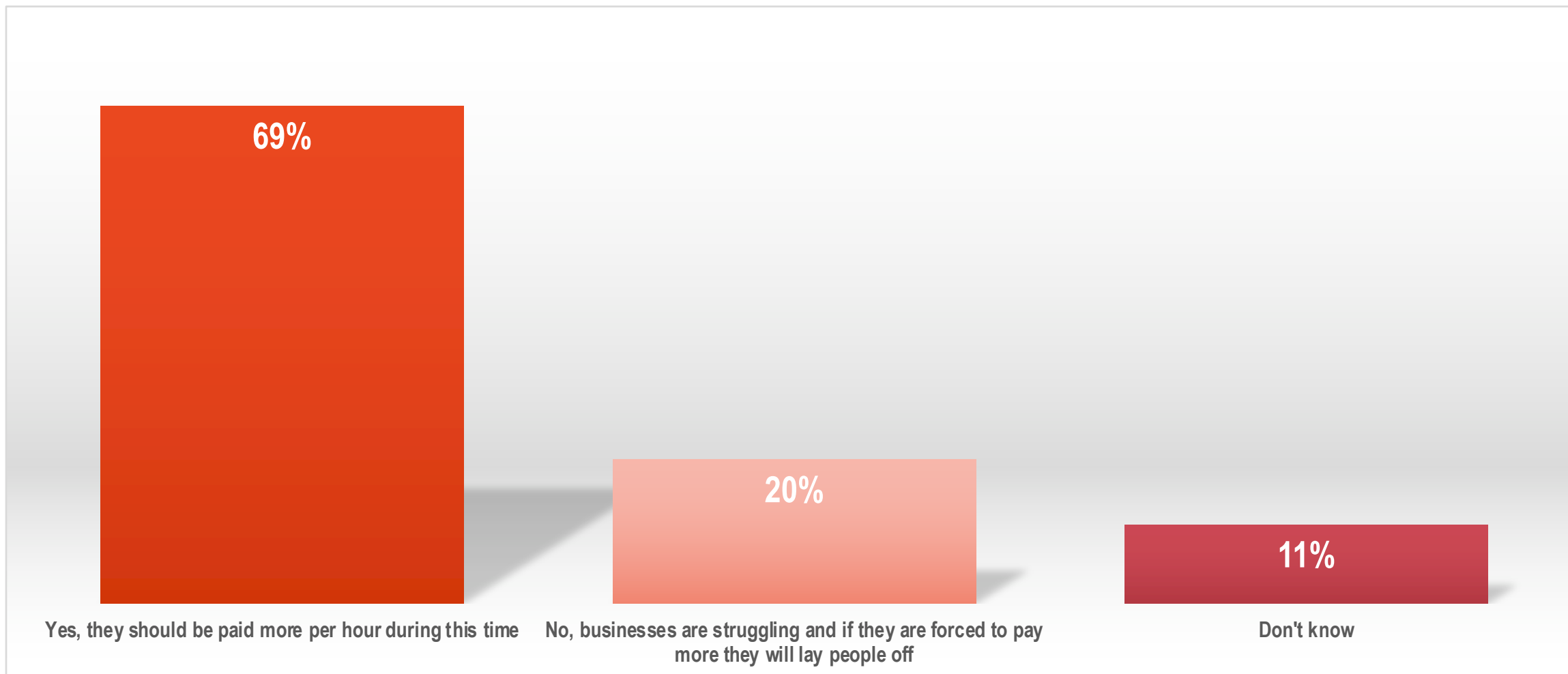


Do you think that grocery stores and retailers like Walmart and Target should limit customer's purchases of essential items in times of crisis or should it be first come first serve?

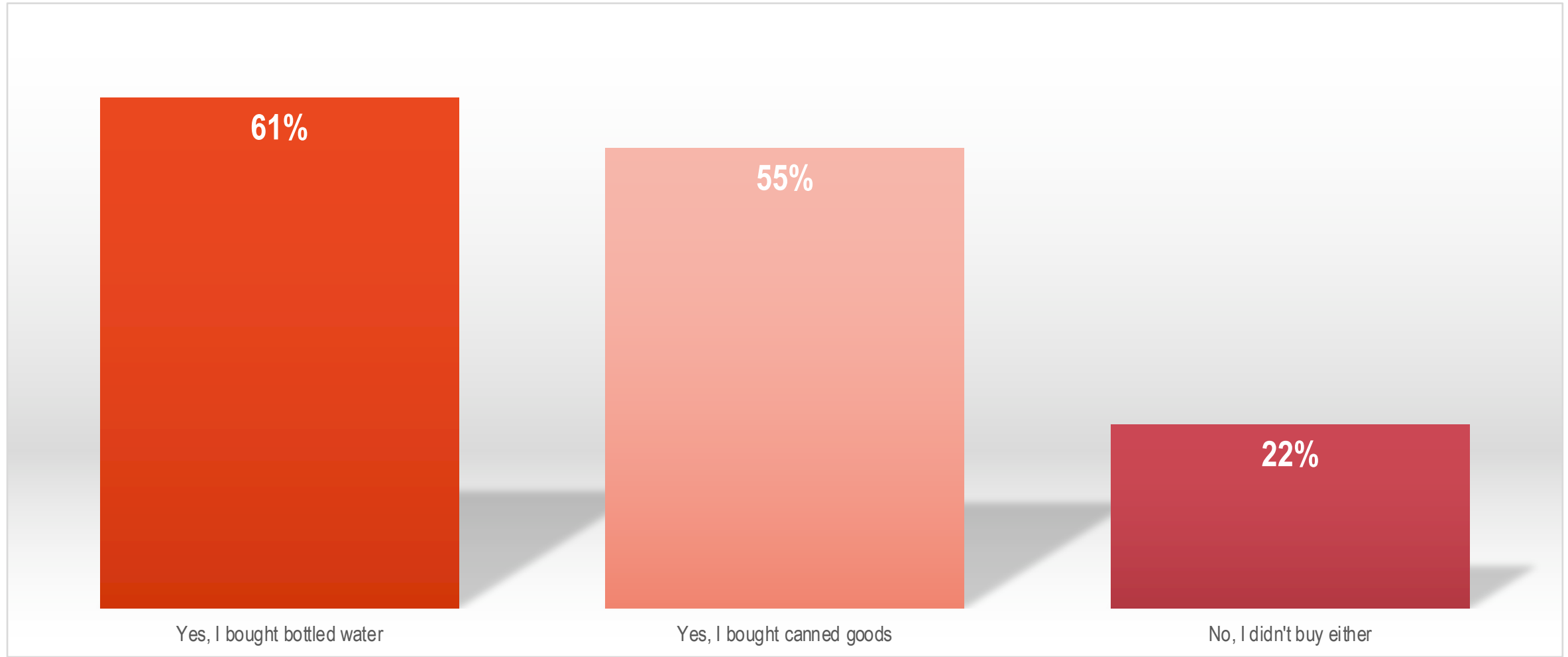

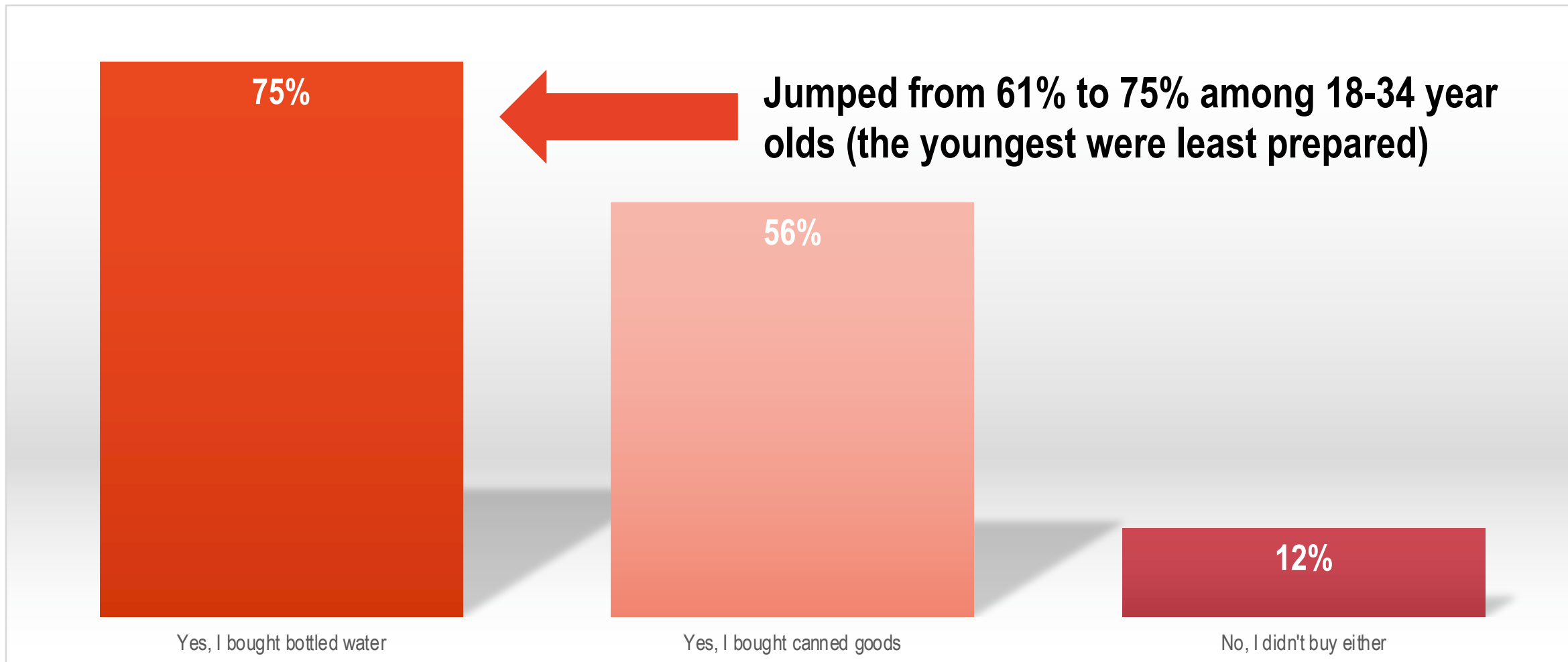
Do you think that the government should mandate hazard pay for those who work in 'essential businesses' like grocery stores, delivery services, and gas stations during the coronavirus crisis?



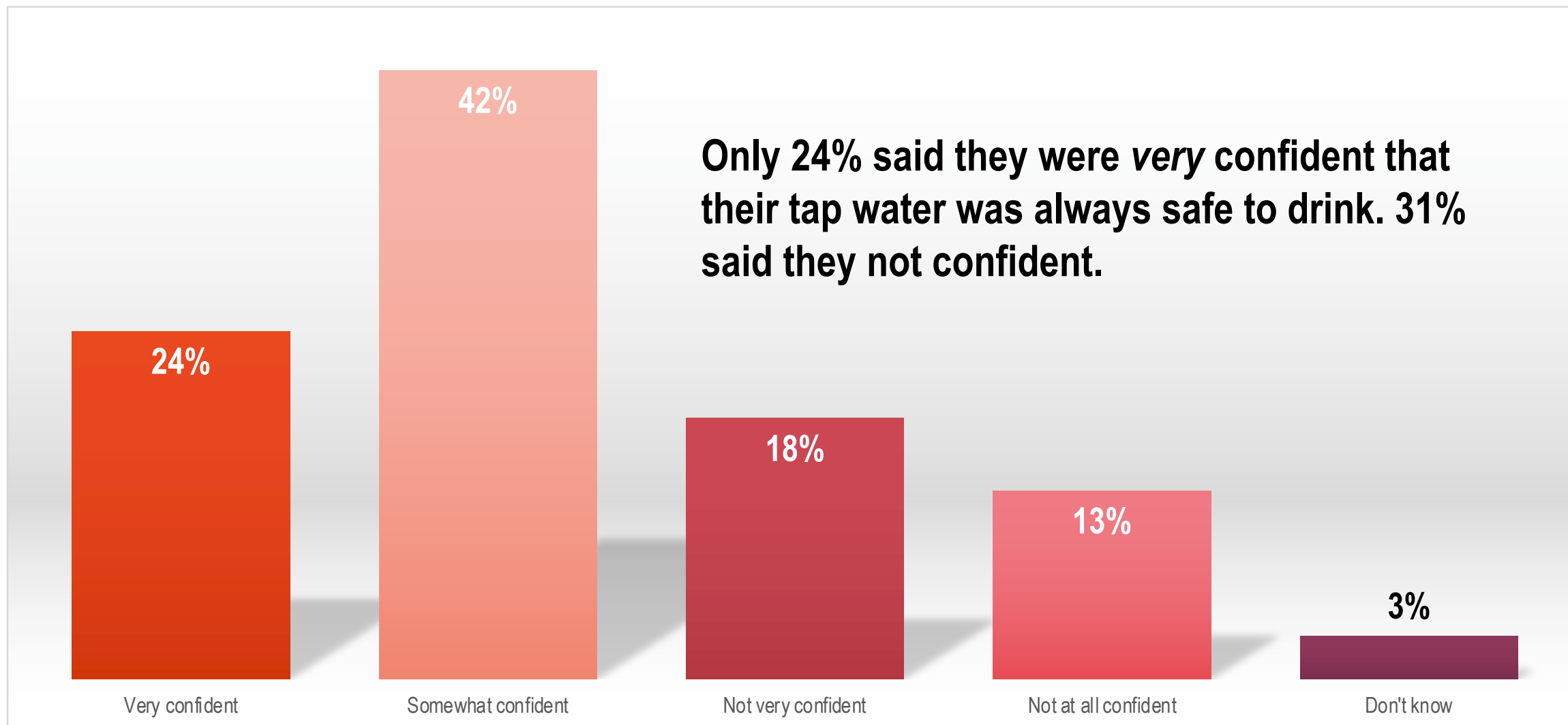
When self-quarantining started in your state, did you buy any bottled water or canned goods to make sure you had enough on hand for your family?
